Question 1:

Please provide TBDSSAB's definition of non-congregate housing? The term is commonly used for accommodations that provides private space for occupants. In the case of this EOI, does it mean private bedrooms? Or private bedrooms with private washrooms? Or private apartments with no shared living space.

Answer 1:

Congregate living settings refer to a range of facilities where people (most or all of whom are not related) live or stay overnight and use shared spaces (e.g., common sleeping areas) including:

- Shelters
- Group homes
- Correctional facilities
- Children or youth residential settings

TBDSSAB is looking for more independent living arrangements where people could have their own private bedroom.
