

Number of Placed Children



Total Child Care Waitlist and Children Currently Waiting for Care (Individual/Unique Children)



Total Waitlist at end of Q3 2025 4,935 Percent of Waitlist Currently Seeking Care at end of Q3 2025






Total Number of Applicants Housed Per Month



Transitional & Supportive Housing: Applicants Housed




Total Number of Applicants Housed Through Transitional and Supportive Housing





Average Time on Waitlist Year over Year in Months







Current Housing Status of Applicants, as at end of Q3^{1,2}




Household Type Demand, as at end of Q3








Ontario Works: Employment Assistance Services



% of OW Caseload Exiting to Employment (Cumulative Year-to-Date)



% of OW Clients* that have Created a Social Assistance Action Plan (Cumulative Year-to-Date)






Ontario Works: Employment Assistance Services
